How to reach Trento

BY PLANE

There is no airport in Trento, so if you are planning to travel by plane, you should try to arrive either in Verona ("Catullo Airport", 90 km). There are daily flights to and from Budapest, Bucharest, Frankfurt, Munich, and Vienna, as well as Rome and other major Italian cities. The shuttle service to Verona Porta Nuova railway station leaves every 20 minutes, and it takes 20 minutes. From there direct trains to Trento take 50 minutes.

BY TRAIN

Two main lines reach Trento: the Brennero line (connecting to Verona, Milano and Rome to the South, and Innsbruck and northern Europe to the North) and the Valsugana line to Venice.

TOWN TRAVEL

The town has an efficient urban travel system (yellow buses) run by Atesina. Extra urban buses are run by the same company and are blue in colour. Go to http://www.atesina.it/ for information. If you visit the Atesina office at the main railway station, you can pick up a free timetable "Guida ai trasporti del Trentino". Taxis can be hailed from anywhere in town or booked by phone - no.
